As we celebrate the UN's 75th anniversary, we invite you to take part of UNA-USA's 2020 campaign initiative:

The Future We Want, and The UN We Need Together

Together, we can ensure that Americans' voices are heard in the global conversation and we leave no one behind in pursuit of the Global Goals.

Throughout this year, UNA-USA will engage its network of 200+ chapters and 20,000 members in the U.S. to conduct "Global Consultations" that will elevate policy recommendations to achieve a sustainable future by 2045. Overall, the Global Consultations will be focused on issues that are relevant to the local and international community.

Our overall goal is to engage Americans in all 50 states.

What is a Global Consultation? An action-oriented discussion led by a moderator, with a series of question prompts for the audience to discuss and respond to throughout the course of the consultation.

Why participate in a Global Consultation? To educate everyday Americans on how to build a global partnership that realizes our shared aspirations for a just, peaceful and sustainable future.

Who will participate in a Global Consultation? These consultations will not only involve UNA-USA members, but also members of civil society, business, and political leaders. In addition, all Members of Congress will be invited to participate in these consultations with their local constituents.

How will a Global Consultation make a difference? Connecting people and amplifying their voices through a Global Consultation will lead to one primary goal: inspire action for a better future. The ideas generated during this session are expected to achieve the following goals:

- 1) *Inform public debate on the role of the United Nations in building a better future;*
- 2) *Suggest action to taken up by national and international decision-makers;*
- 3) *Inspire broader civic engagement;*
- 4) *Deepen global cooperation.*

What will be the outcome of the Global Consultation? Notes and recommendations from the Global Consultation will be provided to the United Nations and key decision makers within the public sector, including Members of Congress. In addition, the results will be developed into a report and uploaded to a microsite that can ladder up to the UN's global platform. Lastly, UNA-USA and the UN Foundation will work with important stakeholders to ensure that recommendations inspire policy actions for a sustainable future by 2045.

What will the Global Consultation focus on?

- **Societal Action:** *What actions do we need to take as a society to ensure that we build a better world for future generations?*
 - **Individual Participation:** *What can you do as an individual to create the world we want? What are you currently doing for a better world?*
 - **Stakeholder Engagement:** *What should be the role of governments / Businesses / Civil society to ensure that we effectively building a better world?*
- International Cooperation:** *How can the Sustainable Development Goals better advance international priorities? What forms of action and collaboration might be needed at local, national and international levels? What type of role might the United Nations and other international institutions have in facilitating this? How can they improve?*
