What is PollEverywhere?

It's an online tool where you can collect and see audience feedback in real-time, as well as save the data for later use.

It's free up to about 25 responses. If you have a larger group (or want to use this for other events as well) you can check out their pricing.

Tools like PollEverywhere can help supplement how you gather information during consultations, making it easier to submit your consultation form.

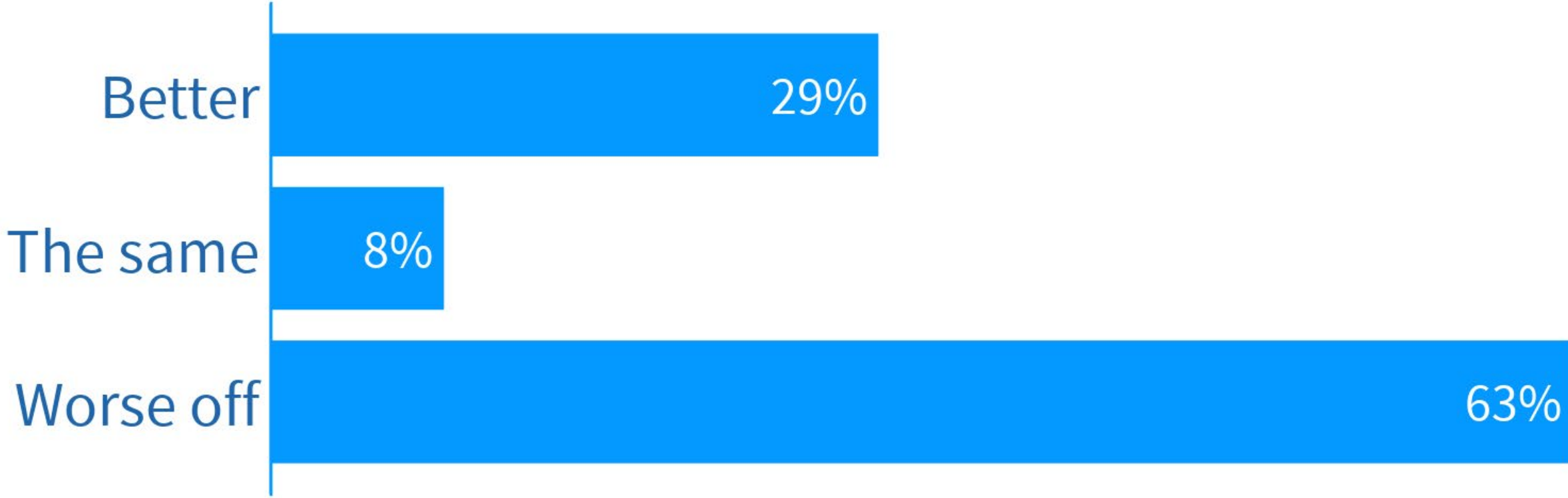

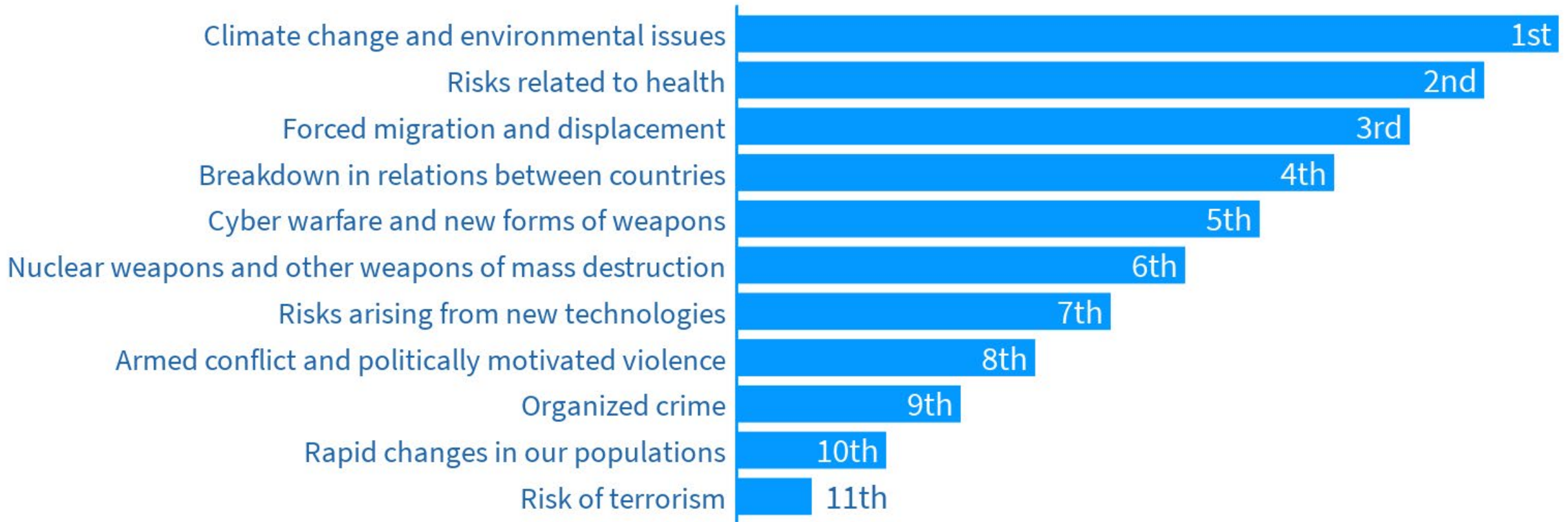

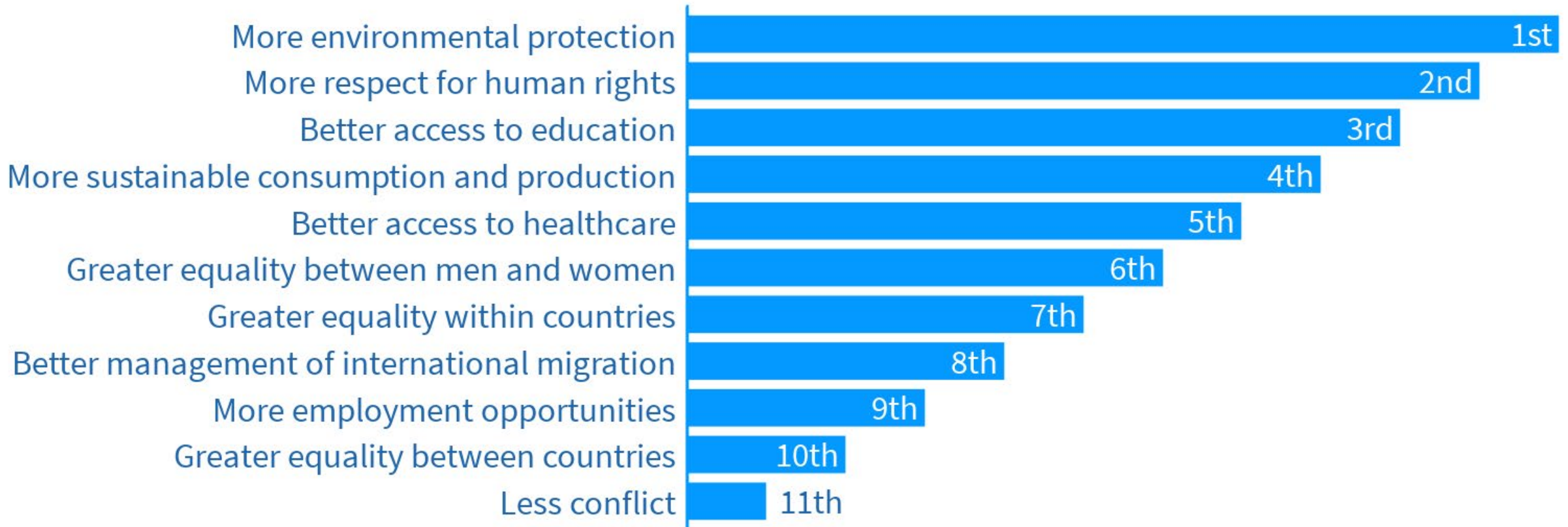
Overall, do you think that people in 2045 will be better off, worse off, the same as you are today?



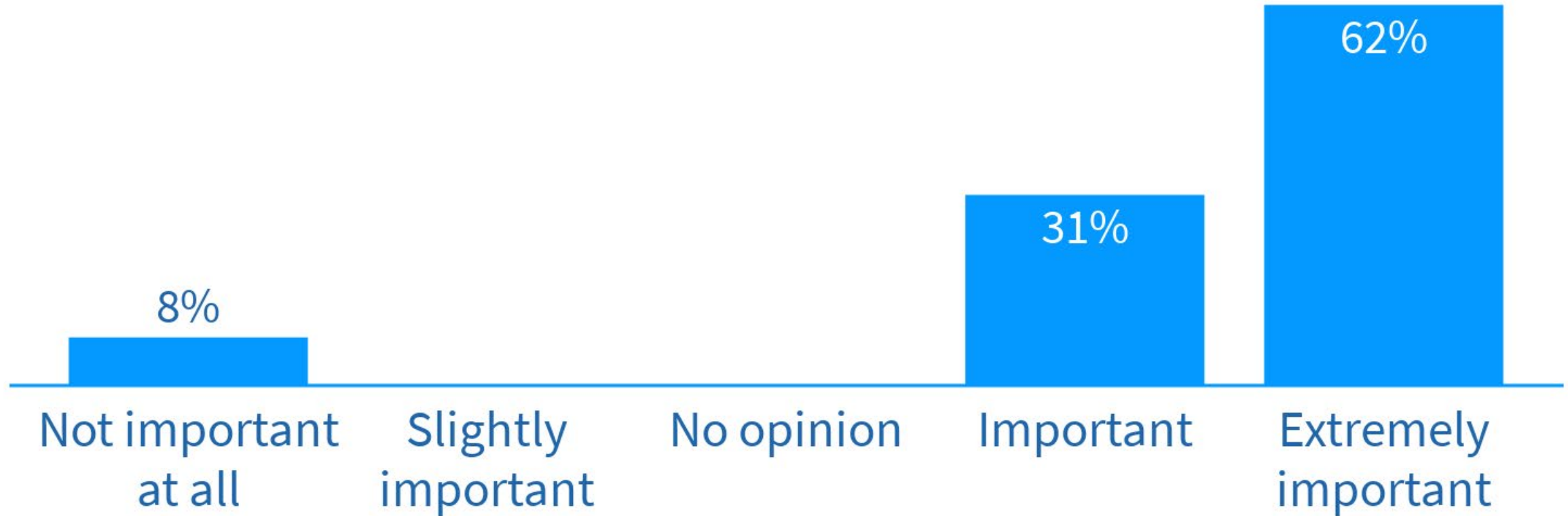
Which of these global trends do you think will most affect our future?

Womxn have deeper track records of community work and collective work. - Push global community to better re envision what is possible. (Outside capitalism? Bottom up economic development? Community level work?)”

“Raise awareness unifying oneness. We are living beings and we must sustain life for the future by thwarting and am chipping away and global issues.”

“Focus on the lowest intersectional identity, consider historical marginalization, abolish and revise metrics to measure disparity, and make

“Educate and advocate. Flood them on their values. Make it relate to them with a sense of urgency.”

“Challenging corporations and stepping up on climate change!”

“Deep education. Deeper analysis of race and power and equity work. Invite input from the specific communities most overlooked.”

“We need them to effectively address and provide solutions of long standing issues as well as arising issues more diligently. Intercultural competence needs to be practiced more”

“Our elected officials need to work more with the international community to collaborate for a better future. This means prioritizing each country's own priorities without completely disregarding the needs of others.”
