In choosing *Association Scholars*, preference is given to male or female students meeting all or most of the following criteria:

- ◆ have demonstrated academic excellence
- ◆ have demonstrated interest in international issues
- ◆ have demonstrated progress in developing fluency in a foreign language and a commitment to continue foreign language study
- ◆ have participated in a Model UN or similar intercultural program
- ◆ have demonstrated financial need
